**Note on Duties:**

Asst. Cook listed first in case of short patrols: if only 5-man patrol his number repeats and he also performs Asst. Setup duty; if only 4-man patrol, both Cooks also perform both Setup duties in swapped roles.

“Cleanup” duty includes cleaning up:

- Dishes & Patrol Gear
- Sump station

“Setup” duty includes setting up:

- Stove & Cook Gear
- All water needed for meal
- Bear-Bag
