Troop Focus

Troop 419 is an advancement focused troop with many activities centered on merit badges, outdoor activities, service projects and character building.

The boys are from many local cities but primarily San Dimas and La Verne diverse in faith, beliefs, and backgrounds.

As a scout lead troop - many of the activities are lead by the boys - there is a strong focus on leadership development.

Troop Activities

As a group, the troop plans the activities for each year. Activities have included attending summer camp at Cherry Valley, Holcomb Valley, and Mataguay; Colorado River Canoe Trip; Joshua Tree Camping and climbing; Snow Camping; Kayaking and fishing trips, local Service Projects; participation in Camporee (2014 award winners!), Scout Expo, and the Rose Parade.



Parent Participation

Troop 419 has a great team of parents that rotate various duties. These duties include merit badge counselors and committee positions (e.g., Treasurer, Secretary, Committee Chair, and Advancement Chair).

Access to regional merit badge counselors round out the skills and interests the scouts can explore.

Fundraising

The Troop organizes and participates in frequent fundraising activities such as Western Days food booth, Bonelli Park Triathlons, wreath sales to raise troop revenues and assist scouts in building individual scout funds.
